HIGHLIGHTS OF ICRDSTHM-2017

Day-1 | 28th April, 2017

The Society for Research Development (SRD) organized an International Conference on “Recent Development in Science, Technology, Humanities and Management” on 28th & 29th April 2017 in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. Over 100 participants from different public, private, research and academic institutions showed interest in this Conference. More than 30 distinguished speakers from all the geographic regions and diverse backgrounds presented their work and research findings in this Conference.

The Day-1 of the Conference was focused on how to raise the standards of research in the thrust areas across the world that could help the mankind and the generations to come. The participants shared their views on emerging trends on research, the problems and the challenges that academic and research institutions are facing and to explore the possibilities of collaborative inter-disciplinary research at international level. The participants also suggested few topics like sustainable energy, disaster management, nanotechnology, water conservation, e-commerce, health resources, etc. in which the governments should focus. It was also discussed that to create interest and to attract the students towards research, the academic institutions should develop STEM and STEAM focused curriculum.

Day-2 | 29th April, 2017

The President of the Society, Dr. R.C. Singh welcomed the participants and highlighted the objectives of the Society that is “to bring together academicians and experts from the globe to exchange knowledge and ideas at a common platform by organizing conference, seminars and workshops that unite the science, social sciences, languages, emerging technologies, management, financial engineering, humanities, literary, cultural and education for the empowerment of research and development. The society promotes the original, innovative ideas for betterment of the world and seeks to propagate the result of the interdisciplinary field across research communities and to the general public”. He informed that for ICRDSTHM-2017 more than 100 papers and articles were received from Hong Kong, Nigeria, Bangladesh, Germany, Iran, Oman, Indonesia, Malaysia, Thailand, Australia, China, Cambodia and India and only 30 papers have been selected for publication after peer review. The papers will be online in International Journal of Computer Applications and International Journal of Applied Information published by Foundation of Computer Science, USA. He also announced that two Best Paper Awards will be given, one from each technical session. He also highlighted the progress and achievements of the Society.

The Conference was inaugurated with a Keynote Address by Professor Hamza Abdul Rahman, University of Malaya, Malaysia. In his keynote address, Prof. Rahman addressed on "What profession expects and what more behavior tells: Ethical Intelligence as an emerging catalytic converter". He focused on how to uncover the underlying factors affecting business participants' behaviors in professional ethics, to diagnose the consequence of deficient ethics on any sort of business sphere, and suggested ways to enhance professional ethics. He concluded his address with following wonderful message:

*Watch your thoughts, they can become words.
Watch your words, they can become actions.
Watch your actions, they can become habits.
Watch your habits, they can become your character.
Watch your character, it determine your dignity.*

The Day-2 of the Conference was divided into two Technical Sessions. The first session was chaired by Dr. Bunlay Nith, Deputy Director General of Higher Education, MOEYS, Cambodia and co-chaired by Dr. P.K. Paul, Raiganj University, West Bengal, India. In this session, 09 speakers from different parts of the globe presented their research work. The second session was chaired by Dr. P.K. Paul and co-chaired by Dr. J.C. Patni, University of Petroleum and Energy Studies, Dehradun, India. In this session, 10 papers were presented by the delegates and 05 Skype presentations were also organized.

The delegates from Malaysia, Hong Kong, China, Indonesia, Australia, Oman, Bangkok, Cambodia and India participated in these sessions. Among all the deliberations two papers were awarded as best paper (one from each session). From the first session, the best paper was awarded to Dr. Sallehuddin Ibrahim for his presentation on "Flow imaging in a vertical gravity flow rig using optical tomography". From second session, the best paper was awarded to Dr. Ling Ling Tan for her deliberation on "Development of optical microbial bio-Sensor for reflectometric nitrite ion detection".

The conference concluded with the Valedictory Session in which Dr. Anil Bhuimali, Vice-Chancellor, Raiganj University, West Bengal, India was conferred "Outstanding University Administrator and Academic Excellence Award" by the Society for his achievements and contributions in academics, administration and in the development of the nation. The Certificates were distributed to all the delegates who presented their work and also who attended this Conference. The Certificates and mementos were also given to Session Chairs and Co-chairs.

Dr. Rajendra Kumar, Member of Society, proposed a Vote of Thanks and thanked all the participants, Organizing and Technical Committees for smooth conduct and huge success of ICRDSTHM-17.
